Boards & Commissions

Planning and Zoning Commission - Meets the 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month
The Commission reviews and makes recommendations to the City Council regarding land development regulations including zoning, subdivision, building and construction, environmental and other regulations controlling, regulating or affecting the use or development of land. The Commission exercises control over platting and subdividing land within the corporate limits and the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the city to insure the consistency of any such plats or subdivision with the adopted Comprehensive Plan. The Commission also serves as the CIP (Capital Improvement Projects) committee.
Term of office – 3 years

Parks & Recreation Advisory Board – Meets 1st Monday of each month
The Parks and Recreation Board is a Council appointed advisory Board that makes recommendations on the Parks and Recreation Department policies and activities.
Term of Office – 3 years

Public Arts Commission – Meets the 2nd Monday of each month
The Public Arts Committee makes recommendations to the City Council to encourage, conduct, sponsor or co-sponsor non-profit programs to further the development and public awareness of, and interest in, fine arts and the performing arts. The mission of the committee is to promote art and education that contributes to a sense of community.
Term of Office – 4 years

TIRZ/Leander Development Authority Board – Meets the 3rd Monday of each month
The TIRZ/Leander Development Authority Board makes recommendations to the City Council concerning the administration of the Reinvestment Zone.
Term of Office - Staggered

Board of Adjustment/Appeal – Meets when needed
The Board of Adjustment/Appeal have the power to hear and determine appeals from the refusal of building permits, appeals resulting from administrative decisions and to permit exception to or variation from the zoning regulations. The Board issues orders and recommends actions to the City Council for repair or removal of substandard and dangerous buildings.
Term of Office – 3 years

Ethics Commission – Meets when needed
The Ethics Commission meets upon a complaint or grievance being filed and has the power to investigate and make recommendations to the City Council and/or City Manager.
Term of Office – No terms

City Charter Review Committee – Meets when needed
The Charter Review Committee makes recommendations for amendments to the City Charter.
Term of Office – 6 months
