**Motion made by Council Member Siebold to approve revision to Section 12.01 to be placed on the May 11, 2013 ballot. Second by Mayor Pro Tem Cantwell. Motion passes, all voting "aye"**

Motion made by Council Member Dishongh to approve revision to Section 5.05, option #1 with recommendation from the City Attorney to include "Authorized by State Law" and removing the rest of the verbiage to be placed on the May 11, 2013 ballot. Second by Mayor Pro Tem Cantwell. Motion passes, all voting "aye"

Motion made by Mayor Pro Tem Cantwell to approve revision (without the word "City") to Section 5.05 (b) to be placed on the May 11, 2013 ballot. Second by Council Member Dishongh. Motion passes, all voting "aye"

Motion made by Mayor Pro Tem Cantwell to approve revision to Section 507 (d) with the wording "not inconsistent with state law" to be added and be placed on the May 11, 2013 ballot. Second by Council Member Garcia. Motion passes, all voting "aye"

Motion made by Council Member Navarrette to approve revision to Section 607 to be placed on the May 11, 2013 ballot. Second by Council Member Dishongh. Motion passes, all voting "aye"

Motion made by Council Member Lynch to approve revision to Section 7.06 to be placed on the May 11, 2013 ballot. Second by Mayor Pro Tem Cantwell. Motion passes, all voting "aye"




