CITY UTILITIES

Application for utility service can be made at the Utility Office located at 200 West Willis or via our website at www.leandertx.gov. Please go to "Utilities Department", select "New Application" and click the "www.2Turniton.com" option. Water, wastewater, and garbage pickup are billed through the City's Utility Department.

The City contracts garbage services through Clawson Disposal Services.

To connect services, a deposit is required from each new customer. After a one-year history of good payment has been established (no late fees or disconnections), 50% of the deposit may be applied to the customer's utility account.

The customer must request in writing that the 50% of their deposit be applied to their account; and the request must be approved by the utilities' supervisor.

Connection fees are required **each** time utilities are connected or transferred.

The City of Leander has four billing cycles. The due date is extended to the next business day when the due date falls on a weekend or holiday. If payment is not received by the due date, services may be interrupted.

For your convenience, a drive-thru drop box, located on the south side of the building, is available 24 hours for payment drop-off. **No cash in drop box.**

All payments received after 5:00 p.m., whether online or at the office, will be applied to the following business day.

Utility meters are read **throughout the month**. Customers are responsible for the timely payment of their account, regardless of whether or not the bill is received.

If the bill is not paid by the due date, a penalty of 10% of the current amount due, but not less than \$10.00 is applied to the account. Utility service will be disconnected if the payment is not received in full at Utility Office on the due date.

If you have not received your bill, please call our office at: 512-259-1142 and we will furnish you with the amount due.

If your account becomes delinquent, the service may be interrupted. Accounts that become delinquent will be responsible to pay a \$40 reinstatement fee whether or not the service has been disconnected.

Building permits are required for all construction other than ordinary maintenance, such as re-painting or cosmetic interior remodeling. Permits are required for new construction, electrical, plumbing, heating and air conditioning, fences, decks, storage buildings, accessory buildings, and pools.
