





1-Go to leander.lib.tx.us, click on the City of Leander logo



- 2- Click on Library Services
- 3- Interlibrary Loan, click on [Interlibrary Loan Request Form](#)
- 4- Submit your completed form*
- 5- The library will contact you when your item is available for pick up.

*By submitting the completed form, the requester understands that he/she is responsible for a \$2.50 handling fee due upon check out, any over due fines, any charges assessed by the lending library, and the replacement cost of the item plus a \$10 processing fee if the item is lost, damaged, or otherwise not returned.
