

Smoke Testing

The City of Leander work crews will be in the Ridgewood and Crystal Crossing Subdivision on July 20th through the 21st 2016 starting on A "SMOKE TEST". This survey will assist our inspection crews in locating breaks and defects in our sewer system. The smoke you see coming from the vent stacks on houses or holes in the ground is NON-TOXIC, NON-STAINING, HAS NO ODOR, and WHITE TO GRAY IN COLOR AND CREATES NO FIRE HAZARD.

The smoke should not enter your home unless you have defective plumbing or dried up drain traps.

It is advisable for the home owner to pour a gallon of water into each drain trap of floors, sinks, showers and tubs prior to our testing. If smoke enters your home there is a good reason to assume that sewer gases may also be entering your home or business. If you are not home and discover smoke when you return, please call us at 512-259-2640.
