Section 3 - Bid Schedule Descriptions: Revisions and clarifications have been made to this section of the Specifications Book. See "Revised Bid Schedule Descriptions – Addendum 1".

Section 4 – Bid Proposal: Revisions have been made to the Bid Proposal. See "Revised Bid Proposal – Addendum 1".

Substitutions: Substitutions for specified products (such as flagpoles, pavers, etc.) will be considered after award of the project. Bidders may indicate recommended substitutions and cost savings at the end of the Bid Proposal, however, these will NOT be used in determining the award of the project.

REVISED BID SCHEDULE DESCRIPTIONS – ADDENDUM 1

(Revisions shown in red)

Bid Items 1 through 15. The Current City of Leander Design and Construction Standards are hereby referred to and included in this contract as fully and to the same extent as if copied at length herein and they shall be applied to this project except as modified/indicated below in these specifications or on the plans.

Bid Item 1. **Mobilization/General Requirements of Contract:** This item covers the movement of personnel, construction equipment, and supplies to the project site or to the vicinity of the project site in order to enable the Contractor to begin work on the project. This item also includes but is not limited to any bonds, insurance, administration and supervision, temporary facilities, construction surveying/staking, existing utility locations, and any other items not accounted for in base bid schedule.

Bid Item 2. **Compliance with SWPPP:** This item covers compliance with the Technical Specifications, Plans, preparation of the SWPPP, submittal of NOI, performance of inspections and maintenance records according to the SWPPP. This item covers the installation of temporary erosion control measures not specifically listed elsewhere as Bid Items but required in accordance with the SWPPP. **Temporary controls include 800 linear feet of silt fence and one (1) stabilized construction entrance.**

Bid Item 3. **Excavation:** **This item covers unclassified excavation and compaction of subgrade and other incidentals required to complete the work within the two plaza areas. All spoils not used for fill, back fill, subgrade shall be disposed of on-site at a location determined by the owner (Ref. Grading Plan Sheets L-12).**

Bid Item 4. **Concrete Plaza at Wall of Honor Overlook:** This item covers the unclassified excavation, subgrade preparation, backfill, reinforced concrete pavement, finishing of concrete, and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail Sheet L-14).

Bid Item 5. **Pavers at Military Flag Overlook:** This item covers the unclassified excavation, subgrade preparation, paver sand bed, brick pavement, mortar, pavers and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail Sheet L-17).

Bid Item 6. **Pavers at Wall of Honor Overlook:** This item covers the unclassified excavation, subgrade preparation, paver sand bed, brick pavement, mortar, pavers and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail Sheet L-17).

Bid Item 7. **Flagpole (20' pole):** This item includes the furnishing and installation of reinforced concrete footing, pole, base plate, flag pole other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail Sheet L-17).

Bid Item 8. Flagpole (25' pole): This item includes the furnishing and installation of reinforced concrete footing, pole, base plate, flag pole other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail Sheet L-16).

Bid Item 9. Military Seal Monument: This item covers the unclassified excavation, subgrade preparation, backfill, reinforced concrete footing, anchor bolts, stone veneer, military seal and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail Sheet L-17)

Bid Item 10. Lighting for Flagpoles at Military Flag Overlook: This item covers the furnishing and installation of light fixture and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Site Electrical Plans).

Bid Item 11. Lighting for Flagpoles at Wall of Honor Overlook: This item covers the furnishing and installation of light fixture and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Site Electrical Plans).

Bid Item 12. Flagpoles at Wall of Honor Overlook: This item covers the unclassified excavation, subgrade preparation, backfill, reinforced concrete footing, anchor bolts, stone veneer, and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail Sheet L-16)

Bid Item 13. Cast Stone Cap: This item covers cast stone, grout, and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail. Sheets L-16, L-17).

Bid Item 14. Railings at Plazas: This item covers the removal and reinstallation railings at the two plazas, sleeves, embedment, grout, metal cutting/finishing and other incidentals required to complete the work (Ref. Detail. Sheets L-15, L-17)

Bid Item 15. Electrical Distribution: This item covers the furnishing and installation of all electrical work from point of primary connection to all distribution panels including but not limited to demolition, unclassified excavation/trenching, boring, backfill, conduit, wire, house panels, racks, transformers, receptacles, and other incidentals required to complete the work. (Ref. Site Electrical Plans). **Clarification – electric conduit and wire to be provided from new panel to each plaza area. Provide conduit with pull string only and terminate in junction box at center of Labyrinth area (Ref. plan sheet L-7 for location).**
